◆ **Open Forum**

Cancelled Meeting – With only three regularly scheduled items on the August 18, 2020 Idaho Building Code Board agenda, the Chairman cancelled the meeting.

◆ **Vote to Authorize Notice of Omnibus Rulemaking – Adoption of Proposed Rule and Notice of Omnibus Fee Rulemaking – Adoption of Proposed Fee Rule with Regard to IDAPA 24.39.30, (Formerly 07.03.01) in Docket Number 24-0000-2000F**

For administrative rules to continue to be effective, the legislature has to reauthorize them each year. This year, similar to last year, the legislature did not reauthorize any rule that had a fee in it. To ensure the fee rules remain in place, the Governor’s office promulgated them on a temporary basis. The Board has the authority to promulgate rules; therefore, DBS asked for its approval to put the rules into a proposed state; getting them further along in the rulemaking process for possible reauthorization at the 2021 legislature.

The rules have not changed since presented to the legislature in 2020; however, DBS has been moved under the Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing, and the IDAPA rules under the Idaho Building Code Board have been recodified from 07.03.01 to 24.39.30.
