

2022 Electrical Apprentice Ratio Adjustment

The following policy applies for contractors who have been granted an apprentice ratio adjustment.

1. All apprentice working under an expanded ratio ***are required to carry an apprentice card that has their level*** on it. This will require all apprentice with five-year apprentice registration cards to provide DBS with work verification and education verification and receive a yearly apprentice registration card. Any apprentice that does not have a one-year card will be considered a level zero for ratio compliance.
2. If a contractor is using a 3:1 ratio: the combined level of all three apprentice registration cards must add up to at least six. Example... 1 journeyman, 1 level three, 1 level two and 1 level one.
3. If a contractor is using a 4:1 ratio: the combined level of all three apprentice registration cards must add up to at least eight. Example... 1 journeyman, 2 level three, 1 level two and 1 apprentice.
4. Maximum 4 apprentices to one journeyman allowed.
5. All apprentices shall be enrolled in or have successfully completed four years of apprenticeship training.
6. Weekly safety meetings will be held and documented.
7. Journeyman and all apprentices will be working in the same apartment unit.

The following contractors have applied for and received a ratio adjustment. This adjustment can be revoked if the contractor is found in violation of the agreed upon ratio adjustment.
